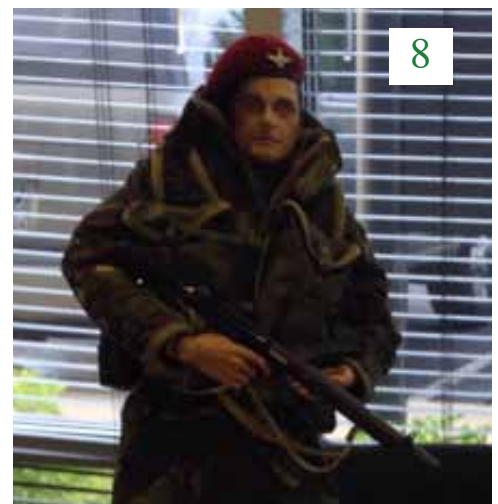

# Pointman gets the basecoat down...

*POINTMAN HAS BEEN WORKING ON A WAFFEN SS OBSERVATION UNIT FOR MONTHS... IT'S GETTING A LITTLE CLOSER TO THE FINISH LINE...*



My sd.kfz 250.5 and sd.kfz. 222 still have some work before they are completed, but I was able to show some progress at the May meeting. The interior of the 250 was completed and then both vehicles were sprayed with Testor's African Mustard. The plan is for camo of dark green in a "spidery" pattern. Then both vehicles will be weathered and receive additional exterior details. These two vehicles are part of a unit that also includes a Panzer III (in Progress), a Dragon Schwimmwagen and about twenty figures. My plan is to have it ready to show at Ft. Thomas this year. - PM
